Come on over and learn about "presents" animals leave behind that tell us they were prowling the area when we weren't looking! Everyone will make plaster tracks to take home!




Saturday, August 13 - Scaly and Slimy!

Learn how to use a compass, then follow a course that will take you through the campground finding surprises! Map orientation will be experienced as well!




Saturday, August 27 - Fish Prints Tell Stories.....

Last program of the season!


