

GFP SEEKING COMMENTS ON CURRENT RESIDENT CANADA GOOSE MANAGEMENT PLAN

PIERRE, S.D. - The South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks (GFP) is seeking comments on the 2010-2014 resident Canada goose management plan prior to drafting the next five-year plan for 2015-2019.

“The current resident Canada goose management plan focused on harvest management tools to reduce crop damage and nuisance problems caused by resident Canada geese while retaining quality hunting and viewing opportunities for Canada geese in South Dakota,” stated Tony Leif, director of the Division of Wildlife.

All individuals interested in Canada goose management in South Dakota have from now through May 10, 2015, to provide suggestions and comments on the plan in its current form.
